2. The upper age limit for the applicants for appointments at the point of entry posts shall be 38 years on the last date of submission of application form (The Vice-chancellor can relax the same in special circumstances).
3. Appointment to the post shall be temporary and its further continuation shall be subject to approval by the competent body/financing agency.
4. The benefit of reservation to the applicants will be available as per provision contained in the Madhya Pradesh Lok Seva (Anusuchit Jatiyon, Anusuchit Jan Jatiyon Aur Anya Pichhade Vergon Ke Liyae Arakshan) Adhiniyam, 1994 and amendment made by the Govt. of M.P. from time to time.
