**EMPLOYMENT NOTICE**

The Lakshadweep Education Department invites application from qualified local candidates for appointment against the posts of **Primary School Teacher**. The details of posts, Pay Band, qualifications required are also shown in **Annexure 'A'** Selection criteria are given in **Annexure 'B'**

Application in plain paper with attested copies of certificates with mark lists, Birth Certificate, Educational qualification, Scheduled Tribe Certificate by the local Scheduled Tribe candidates or certificate from Competent Authority to prove as local wherever applicable etc. should be sent to the Director of Education, Union Territory of Lakshadweep, Kavaratti to reach on or before **30.05.2014 at 6 PM**. Application received without proof of age, Educational qualification etc. and after the due date and time will not be entertained.

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi has already conducted Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) for the purpose of recruitment to the posts of Primary School Teachers. The minimum eligibility criteria for applying to the post of Primary School Teachers (Class I-V) is 90 marks out of 150 for the local general candidates whereas for local ST candidates the marks required is 82.5 marks out of 150 for the Paper - I (Primary stage) and for the post of Primary School Teachers (Classes VI-VIII) is 90 marks out of 150 for the local general candidates whereas for local ST candidates the marks required is 82.5 marks out of 150 marks for the Paper - II (Elementary stage) in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET). Further, the local general differently abled candidates required to score a minimum of 82.5 (55%) marks in the CTET and the local ST differently abled candidates required to score a minimum of 75 (50%) marks in the CTET to qualify for the post of Primary School Teacher. The candidates who have not attained minimum cut off marks in respective papers in CTET are not eligible to apply for the post.

It is further informed that misrepresentation or falsification of facts detected at any stage of the selection process shall result in cancellation of his / her candidature without any notice. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. Directorate of Education reserves the right to initiate legal action against the candidate concerned. The defaulter candidate will be debarred from future recruitments a specific period or permanently.


