2. Eligibility Condition:

A. For the Post of Driver:

- a) Not below the age of 21 years and above 32 years of age as on **13.10.2014.** Upper age limit shall be relaxed in respect of reserved categories as per relevant rules.
- b) Be able to speak, read and write Odia and must have passed at least a test in Odia equivalent to the M.E. standard.
- c) Must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (10+2) or its equivalent from any recognized School, Board or institution.
- d) Should possess a valid licence for Light Motor Vehicle.
- e) Knowledge of motor mechanism and experience of driving a motor car for at least three years.
- f) Must not have more than one spouse living, if married.
- g) Be of good character and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of his duties in the service.
- h) Must not be an accused or convict in any criminal proceeding involving moral turpitude.

B. For the Post of Process Server/ Peon/ Orderly/ NWM/ Sweeper etc.:

- a) Must have passed Class VIII Examination from any recognized educational institution.
- b) Not below the age of 18 years and above 37 years of age as on 13.10.2014.
- c) Be able to speak, read and write Odia and must have passed at least a test in Odia equivalent to the M.E. standard.
- d) Be of good character, sound health, good physique, free from organic or bodily infirmity and any communicable disease.
- e) Must not have more than one spouse living, if married.
- f) Must not be an accused or convict in any criminal proceeding involving moral turpitude.

3 Process of selection:

A. For the Post of Driver:

There shall be a written examination and Trade Test.

The standard, syllabus and subject of examination shall be decided by the Board constituted for the purpose and shall be intimated to the candidates in due course. The candidates qualified in the written test shall be called for Trade Test.

B. For the Post of Process Server/ Peon/ Orderly/ NWM/ Sweeper etc.:

Selection to the posts shall be through a written competitive examination followed by viva voce examination. The scheme of such examination is mentioned herein as below:

The candidates qualified in the written tests shall be called for viva-voce test.

4. Fees for examination:

The candidates applying for Group-C posts are required to deposit fees of Rs. 100/-(Rupees One hundred) only in shape of Treasury Challan under the head "0070-Other Administrative Services-01-Administration of Justice-501-Services and Service Fees-9904650-Law Department-9916730-Examination fees for recruitment conducted by Orissa District & Sub-ordinate Courts" alongwith their application forms.

The candidates belonging to S.C. & S.T. category and candidates applying for Group-D posts shall not be required to pay any fee for the recruitment examination.
